Midhurst Town

Severals Road: Bepton.

Burglary to shed: Believed overnight on 09/06/10 & 10/06/10 garden shed broken into. Hinges unscrewed to gain entry. 2 x wet suits stolen.

North Street: Midhurst.

Anti-Social behaviour: Report received of a group of youths jumping on cars and a post box.

Vandalism: Between 1900hrs 12/06/10 & 1213hrs 13/06/10 a fence at above location has been interfered with and the lifebelts are missing.

Damage to vehicle: Between 0100hrs & 0724hrs on 14/06/10 a Volvo was damaged. Front lights smashed and wing mirror broken off.

Theft from vehicle: Between 1200hrs & 1230hrs on 16/06/10 a Ford Fiesta was broken into. Handbag stolen.

River:

Burglary to shed: Between 2130hrs 11/06/10 & 0700hrs 12/06/10 a garden shed was broken into. The lock was forced to gain entry. A Honda lawnmower, petrol cans and a bicycle were stolen. A nearby fence was also damaged, believed when offenders made their escape.

Damage to vehicle: Between 0010hrs & 0030hrs on 13/06/10 a Vauxhall Astra was damaged. Both wing mirrors smashed off.

School Lane: Fittleworth.

Fight: Police were called to a report of a fight outside the Fittleworth Sports Club. No offences at the club persons who had been drinking heavily asked to leave prior to Police arrival.
